RE: Repeal of Obama Care "Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act"

In your efforts to Repeal Obama Care, please take into account that not only must this bill be repealed but that there are other provisions in other legislation that also must be repealed.

Obama Care was actually passed in two different bills. The first part was in the stimulus bill That bill created two new organizations which must be eliminated along with the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act

1. **Federal Coordinating Council for Comparative Effectiveness Research**

and its funding of \$1.1 Billion Dollars need to be stopped. This amount of funding indicates that this is to be a new huge bureaucracy with never ending requirements for more money.

This group's purpose is to examine the various treatments for a particular problem taking into account the cost of the treatment and the life expectancy, and this determines a ratio and that ratio will determine what treatment will be given to the patient

2. **The National Coordinator for Health Information Technology** whose job it is starting January 1, 2013, to (Item 4) "Provide appropriate information to help guide medical decisions at the time and place of Care" What this means is the agency will be looking over the doctor's shoulder at the time of care and prescribing what can and cannot be done. No longer will the decision be in the individual doctor's hand.

If the doctor disagrees and uses a different treatment then he will be severely punished. While these punishments have not yet been written by the Secretary of HHS, the discussions with physicians is that the first violation is a \$100,000 fine and the second violation is jail time, and loss of license.

Please keep this in mind as you go about your business of repealing this onerous legislation.
